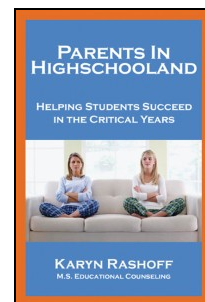
Karyn devoted thirty-three years to a busy career in education, working as a counselor to the teen-aged subculture in California high schools—without ever a dull moment!
